Roasted Chicken & Leftover Chicken Salad

- 4-6 Large Split chicken Breasts
- 3 Tbsp. honey
- 4 Tbsp. whole mustard
- Salt & pepper
- 1/4 c Teriyaki sauce
- Baste chicken w/ above ingredients and bake for 1-1 1/2 hrs. @375° until no longer pink.
- Chop leftover chicken. Stir in 3-4 Tbsp. light mayo, 2-3 Tbsp. honey, 2 Tbsp. whole mustard, 1 c grapes, halved, and 1/2c chopped pecans or walnuts.
